Alexander, Jill S. *The Sweetheart of Prosper County* This year, Austin Gray is going to wave to the crowd from in the annual No-Jesus Christmas Parade, and finally show the town bully that she's got what it takes to be the Sweetheart of Prosper County!

Asher, Jay. Thirteen Reasons Why

When Clay Jenkins receives a box in the mail containing thirteen cassette tapes recorded by his classmate Hannah, who committed suicide, he spends a night crisscrossing their town, listening to Hannah's voice recounting the events leading up to her death.

Bauer, Michael Gerard. *Don't Call Me Ishmael*Fourteen-year-old Ishmael Leseur is certain that his name is the cause of his unhappy school life as the victim of the worst bully in his class, but when a new boy arrives, he shows Ishmael that things could be different.

Berk, Josh. *The Dark Days of Hamburger Halpin* When Will Halpin transfers from his all-deaf school into a mainstream Pennsylvania high school, he faces discrimination and bullying, but still manages to solve a mystery surrounding the death of a popular football player in his class.

Buchanan, Michael. The Fat Boy Chronicles: Inspired by a True Story

Overweight and bullied by his classmates, teenaged Jimmy Winterpock relates in his English class journal the life-changing events of his freshman year in high school.

Cohen, Joshua. Leverage

Danny excels at gymnastics but is bullied, like the rest of the gymnasts, by members of the football team, until an emotionally and physically scarred new student joins the football team and forms an unlikely friendship with him.

Collins, B.R. The Traitor Game

Fifteen-year-old Michael and his friend Francis both feel betrayed when someone at their private school learns of Evgard, a secret fantasy world they created together, but when a sadistic bully becomes involved in Michael's plan for revenge, the boys and Evgard face grave danger.

Garden, Nancy. Endgame

Fifteen-year-old Gray Wilton, bullied at school and ridiculed by an unfeeling father for preferring drums to hunting, goes on a shooting rampage at his high school.

Griffin, Adele. The Julian Game

In an effort to improve her social status, a new student at an exclusive girls' school uses a fake online profile to help a popular girl get back at her ex-boyfriend, but the consequences are difficult to handle.

Harmon, Michael. Brutal

Forced to leave Los Angeles for life in a quiet California town, rebellious sixteen-year-old Poe rails against a high school system that allows elite students special privileges and tolerates bullying.

Hautman, Pete. Blank Confession

A new and enigmatic student named Shayne appears at high school one day, befriends the smallest boy in the school, and takes on a notorious drug dealer before turning himself in to the police for killing someone.

Kraus, Daniel. Rotters

Sixteen-year-old Joey's life takes a very strange turn when his mother's tragic death forces him to move from Chicago to rural lowa with the father he has never known, and who is the town pariah.

Love, Anne. Defying the Diva

During Haley's freshman year, a campaign of gossip and bullying causes her to be socially ostracized, but after spending the summer living with her aunt, making new friends, and dating a hunky lifeguard, she learns how to stand up for herself and begins to trust again.

Marino, Peter. Magic and Misery

TJ, a sturdy teenaged girl with little self-confidence, becomes best friends with a new, gay student in her high school, and when he is bullied and she tries to convince him to tell the authorities, he refuses.

McGowen, Anthony. *The Knife that Killed Me*Paul is a loner until, just as he is becoming friends with
"the freaks," the school bully encourages Paul to join his
gang and gives him a knife to carry as an incentive.



Myers, Walter Dean. Shooter

Written in the form of interviews, reports, and journal entries, the story of three troubled teenagers ends in a tragic school shooting.

Peters, Julie Ann. By the Time You Read This, I'll be Dead

Daelyn Rice, who's been bullied throughout high school and has more than once attempted suicide, again makes plans to kill herself, in spite of the persistent attempts of an unusual boy to draw her out.

Phillips, Suzanne. Burn: A Novel

Bullied constantly during his freshman year in high school, Cameron's anger and isolation grows, leading to deadly consequences.

Pixley, Marcella. Freak

Miriam, poetic, smart, and quirky, is considered a freak by the popular girls at her middle school, and she eventually explodes in response to their bullying, revealing an inner strength she did not know she had.

Prose, Frank. Bullyville

After the death of his father, Bart wins a scholarship to the local preparatory school and there encounters a vicious bully whose cruelty compounds the aftermath of the tragedy.

Prue, Sally. The Devil's Toenail

When he finds a strange weathered stone on the beach, thirteen-year-old Steve decides to pretend that it has mysterious powers that can protect him from bullying and can help him impress the gang he wants to join.

Rue, Ginger. Jump: A Novel

A bullying, narcissistic high school junior discovers the transforming power of compassion when she literally "walks in someone else's shoes."

Shulman, Mark. Scrawl

When eighth-grade school bully Tod and his friends get caught committing a crime on school property, his penalty - staying after school and writing in a journal under the eye of the school guidance counselor - reveals aspects of himself that he prefers to keep hidden.
