Carter, Ally. **I'd Tell You I Love You, But Then I'd Have to Kill You**



Crockett, S.D. **After the Snow**

Cross, Julie. **Tempest**

After his girlfriend Holly is fatally shot, nineteen-year-old Jackson travels back in time two years, where he falls in love with Holly all over again, learns that his father is a spy, and encounters powerful enemies.



Farmer, Nancy. **House of the Scorpion**

In a future where humans despise clones, Matt enjoys special status as the young clone of El Patrón, the 142-year-old leader of a corrupt drug empire.

Grant, Michael. **BZRK**

In the near future, the conjoined Armstrong twins, under the guise of the Armstrong Fancy Gifts Corporation, plot to create their own version of utopia using nanobots, while a guerilla group known as BZRK develops a DNA-based biot that can stop bots, but at risk of the host's brain.

Harmon, Michael. **The Chamber of Five**

When Jason Weatherby is invited to join the secretive Chamber of Five, an elite group of students who run Lambert School for the Gifted via a shadow government, he sees how corrupt the institution is and decides to work from the inside to take it down.

Henry, April. **The Night She Disappeared**

Gabie and Drew set out to prove that their missing co-worker Kayla is not dead, while the police search for her body and the man who abducted her.

Hobbs, Will. **Take Me to the River**


When fourteen-year-old Dylan joins his cousin in running the Rio Grande River, they face a tropical storm and a fugitive kidnapper.

At the Academy of Tildor, the training ground for elite soldiers, Cadet Renee de Winter struggles to keep up with her male peers and prove herself in a world of crime and political intrigue.

Littke, Lael. **Lake of Secrets**

Having arrived in her mother's home town to try to find her long-missing brother, Carlene finds herself haunted by memories from a past life.

Marchetta, Melina. **Froi of the Exiles**



Meyer, Marissa. **Cinder**

Paulsen, Gary. **Hatchet** \*Juvenile Fiction  
After a plane crash, thirteen-year-old Brian spends fifty-four days in the wilderness, learning to survive with a hatchet given him by his mother - and learning also to survive his parents' divorce.

Pratchett, Terry. **Dodger**  
In an alternative version of Victorian London, Dodger, a cunning street urchin, unexpectedly rises in life when he saves a mysterious girl and unintentionally puts a stop to the murders of Sweeny Todd.

Reich, Kathryn. **Code: A Virals Novel**  
The Virals are put to the ultimate test when they find a geocache containing an ornate puzzle box - and clues that lead to a bomb.

Sachar, Louis. **Holes**  
Stanley Yelnats is sent to a hellish correctional camp in the Texas desert where he finds his first real friend, a treasure, and a new sense of himself.

Strasser, Todd. **Kill You Last**  
When three teenage clients of her fashion photographer dad go missing, Shelby's near perfect life crumbles when her dad is named a prime suspect in the girls' disappearance.

Update, Eleanor. **Montmorency: Thief, Liar, Gentleman?**  
In Victorian London, a thief utilizes the knowledge he gains in prison and from the scientific lectures he attends as a case study exhibit to create a new, highly successful, double life for himself.



Ward, Rachel. **Numbers**  
When Jem looks at someone she knows the exact date they'll die, so she avoids relationships, but things change when she meets a boy named Spider.

Weyn, Suzanne. **The Bar Code Tattoo**  
The bar code tattoo. Everybody's getting it. It will make your life easier, they say. But what if you say no? What if you don't want to become a code? For Kayla, this one choice changes everything. She becomes an outcast in her high school and there's no option but to run . . . For her life.

Whyman, Matt. **Goldstrike**  
After escaping Camp Twilight, Carl and his girlfriend begin a new life in London, where he attempts to program a highly intelligent supercomputer to help protect them from the CIA and assassins.

Yancey, Rick. **The 5th Wave**  
After the 1st wave, only darkness remains. After the 2nd, only the lucky escape. And after the 3rd, only the *unlucky* survive. After the 4th wave, only one rule applies: trust no one. Now, it's the dawn of the 5th wave, and on a lonely stretch of highway, Cassie runs from Them. The beings who only look human, who roam the countryside killing anyone they see.
