 When Helen starts having dreams about three ancient, hideous women and then tries to kill a classmate at her new school, she discovers that she is playing out an old tale involving Helen of Troy, the Three Furies, and a mythic battle.

Ashton, Brodi. **Everneath**  
 Regretting her decision to forfeit her life on Earth to become an immortal on Everneath, a world between Earth and Hell, teenaged Nikki is given the chance to return to the Surface for six months.

Barrett, Tracy. **King of Ithaka**  
 When sixteen-year-old Telemachos and his two best friends, one a centaur, leave their life of privilege to undertake a quest to find Telemachos's father Odysseus, they learn much along the way about what it means to be a man and a king.

Barron, T. A. **Great Tree of Avalon**  
 In accordance with prophecy, Avalon's existence is threatened in the year that stars stop shining and both the dark child and Merlin's heir will be revealed.

Block, Francesca Lia. **Love in the Time of Global Warming** \*CURRENTLY ON ORDER  
 Seventeen-year-old Penelope (Pen) has lost everything - her home, her parents, and her ten-year-old brother. Like a female Odysseus in search of home, she navigates a dark world full of strange creatures, gathers companions and loses them, finds love and loses it, and faces her mortal enemy.

Cabot, Meg. **Avalon High**  
 Having moved to Annapolis, Maryland, with her medievalist parents, high school junior Ellie enrolls at Avalon High School where several students may be reincarnations of King Arthur and his court.



Cadnum, Michael. **The Legend of Orpheus and Eurydice**  
 Orpheus undertakes a terrifying journey to ask the rulers of the Underworld to return Princess Euridice, his beloved bride, after she is killed by a serpent.

Cross, Sarah. **Kill Me Softly**  
 When Mira runs away to discover her secret past, she finds a place where Grimm's fairy tales come to life, and she cannot avoid her accursed fate.

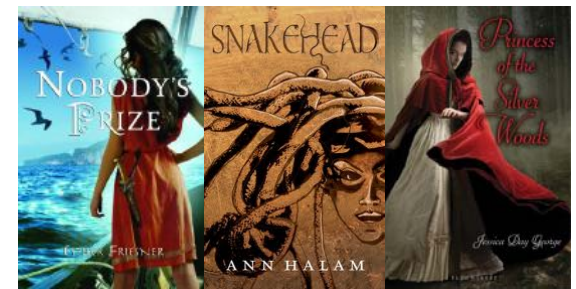
Damico, Gina. **Croak**  
 Fed up with her wild behavior, Lex's parents ship her off to live with her Uncle Mort - a farmer - for the summer. But Uncle Mort's true occupation is much dirtier than shoveling manure. He's a Grim Reaper. And he's going to teach Lex the family business.

Dokey, Cameron. **Kissed**  
 Absence makes the heart grow fonder - and love grow stronger - in three romantic fairy tale retellings of traditional stories: Beauty and the Beast, the Magic Flute, and the Snow Queen.

Doman, Regina. **Rapunzel Let Down**  
 A teen summer romance in New England has disastrous consequences when the daring son of a conservative senator forms a secret relationship with the isolated daughter of a reclusive scientist.

Druitt, Troy. **Corydon & The Island of Monsters**  
 Corydon, an outcast Greek boy with the leg of a goat, learns that he is part of an old prophecy and joins forces with Medusa and other "monsters".

Flinn, Alex. **Towering**  
 Rachel spends her days and nights alone in a tower. Then Wyatt arrives in town. He can't understand why no one in this town is bothered all the missing teenagers - or why no one else hears the girl singing.



Friesner, Esther. **Nobody's Prize**  
 Princess Helen of Sparta disguises herself as a boy to join her unsuspecting brothers as part of the crew of the Argo, the ship commanded by Prince Jason in his quest for the Golden Fleece.

George, Jessica Day. **Princess of the Silver Woods**  
 Petunia and her many sisters take on bandits, gnomies, and the new King Under Stone to end their family curse once and for all.

Halam, Ann. **Snakehead**  
 When a beautiful stranger arrives on his island, Perseus - the son of Zeus and a mortal princess - is smitten. But Andromeda isn't all she seems.

Hale, Shannon. **Goose Girl**  
 Princess Anidori is betrayed by her guards and her lady-in-waiting and must become a goose girl to survive until she can reveal her true identity and reclaim the crown that is rightfully hers.

Harrison, Mette Ivie. **The Princess and the Snowbird**  
 A girl whose magic allows her to take animal form falls in love with a boy who has no magic at all, and together they join forces, trying to defeat an enemy who is out to eliminate all magic everywhere.

Levine, Gail. **Fairest**  
 In a land where beauty and singing are valued above all else, Aza eventually comes to accept her unconventional appearance and her magical voice.

Lo, Malinda. **Ash**  
 In this variation on Cinderella, Ash must choose between a handsome fairy cursed to love her and the King's Huntress whom she loves.



Marsh, Katherine. **The Night Tourist**  
 After Jack has a near fatal accident he meets Euri, a young ghost who introduces him to New York's Underworld and Jack vows to find his mother there.

McKinley, Robin. **Spindle's End**  
 The infant princess Briar Rose is cursed on her name day by an evil fairy and then whisked away by a young fairy to be raised in a remote part of a magical country, unaware of her real identity.

Moss, Jenny. **Shadow**  
 When Shadow - whose job all her life has been to stay close to the young queen and prevent her prophesied death at the age of sixteen - fails in her task, she escapes and embarks upon a journey that eventually reveals her true identity.

Pattou, Edith. **East**  
 In this retelling of "East of the Sun and West of the Moon", a young woman journeys to a distant castle on the back of a great white bear who is the victim of a cruel enchantment.

Picoult, Jodi. **Between the Lines**  
 Told in their separate voices, sixteen-year-old Prince Oliver, who wants to break free of his fairy tale existence, and fifteen-year-old Delilah, a loner obsessed with Prince Oliver and the book in which he exists, work together to seek his freedom.

Shulman, Polly. **The Grimm Legacy**  
 When Elizabeth gets an after-school job as a page at the "New-York Circulating Material Repository", she's drawn into a series of adventures involving mythical creatures and stolen goods.

Shusterman, Neal. **Dread Locks**  
 When fifteen year old Parker Baer meets the girl next door, he finds his life taking a menacing turn as he begins to absorb some of her terrible powers.



Tomlinson, Heather. **Toads and Diamonds**  
 A retelling of the Perrault fairy tale set in pre-colonial India, in which two stepsisters receive gifts from a goddess. As the sisters' fates hang in the balance, each struggles to understand her gift. Will it bring her wisdom, good fortune, love . . . or death?

Valentino, Serena. **Fairest of All: A Tale of the Wicked Queen**  
 Examines the life of Snow White's stepmother to find out just what it is that makes her so evil that she would try to cut out her teenage step-daughter's heart and have it delivered in a locked keepsake box.

Whitman, Emily. **Radiant Darkness**  
 Persephone falls in love and runs off to the Underworld with Hades, but when her mother threatens to destroy the earth to save her, Persephone finds a way to come back once a year, bringing spring.

Yancey, Richard. **The Extraordinary Adventures of Alfred Kropp**  
 After Alfred Kropp's uncle tricks him into stealing Excalibur - the legendary sword of King Arthur - and then he unwittingly gives the sword to a man with enormously evil intentions, he sets off to right his wrong and save the world from imminent destruction.
