Ashton, Victoria. Rich Girls: A Novel

Bauer, Joan. Rules of the Road

Seventeen-year-old Jenna's job at crusty Mrs. Gladstone's shoe store leads to her driving Mrs. Gladstone across the country to Texas to prevent a company takeover.

Brian, Kate. Private: A Novel

When fifteen-year-old Reed wins a scholarship to Easton Academy, she quickly discovers the A-list Billings Girls and tries to become a member. But she soon finds that everyone at Easton is just a bit more sophisticated, a bit more gorgeous, and a lot wealthier than she ever thought possible.

Castellucci, Cecil. The Queen of Cool

Bored with her life, popular high school junior Libby signs up for an internship at the zoo and discovers that the "science nerds" she meets there may have a few things to teach her about friendship and life.

Coburn, Jake. Prep

Three teenage girls from different backgrounds work for a summer in the Hamptons as au pairs for a wealthy family, and in spite of many ups and downs, all three end up changing for the better.

Dean, Zoey. The A-List

Seventeen-year-old blueblood Anna Percy leaves Manhattan to spend the second half of her senior year with her father in Los Angeles and quickly becomes involved in the lives of the rich and famous at Beverly Hills High School.

Dessen, Sarah. This Lullaby

Made cynical by her romance novelist mother's five failed marriages, Remy Starr is stunned to discover that her heart may not be made of stone, when she reluctantly falls for quirky-cute Dexter the summer before she leaves for college.

Friedman, Aimee. South Beach

On a trip to a place where anything can happen - and does - two ex-best friends discover that a chance encounter can lead to the chance of a lifetime. This year, Spring Break is going to be scandalous!!

Godbersen, Anna. The Luxe

Koss, Amy Goldman. The Girls

Each of the girls in a middle-school clique reveals the strong, manipulative hold one of the group exerts on the others, and the hurt and self-doubt that it causes them.

Mackler, Carolyn. *The Earth, My Butt and Other Big Round Things*

When her best friend moves away, Virginia learns how to manage her weight, her love life, and an accusation of date rape against her older brother, all on her own.

Mechling, Lauren and Laura Moser. *The Rise and Fall of a 10th Grade Social Climber*

Wasserman, Robin. Lust
