Barraclough, Lindsey. Long Lankin

When Cora and her sister are sent to stay with their Auntie Ida in an isolated village, they discover that they are in danger from a centuries-old evil and must uncover the horrifying truth before it's too late.

Billingsley, Franny. Chime

Briony, who can see spirits, feels responsible for her twin sister's horrible injury until a young man enters their lives.

Blake, Kendare. *Anna Dressed in Blood*For three years, Cas has carried on his father's work of dispatching the murderous dead, but everything changes when he meets Anna, a girl unlike any ghost he has faced before.

Brennan, Sarah. *Unspoken*

Kami's best friend is someone she's never met - a boy she talks to in her head. When the mysterious Lynburn family returns to her English town, disturbing events begin to occur and the key to it all just might be the boy in her head. The boy she thought was imaginary is real, and dangerous.

Cabot, Meg. *Abandon*

Though she tries returning to the life she knew before the accident, Pierce can't help but feel at once a part of this world, and apart from it. Escape from the realm of the dead is impossible when someone there wants you back.
