

City Manager Emergency Order Corvallis-Benton County Public Library Code of Conduct Addendum

City of Corvallis



To create a safer environment for patrons and staff and mitigate the risk of the spread of COVID-19, we are asking everyone who enters our libraries or utilizes our walkup services to adhere to the following guidelines along with the original <u>Patron Code of Conduct</u>. These amendments shall be in place until guidance from the Oregon Health Authority indicates they are no longer necessary and/or declares that the state has reached Phase 3 of the Reopening Oregon plan.

- 1. Please respect the safety of staff and other patrons. Do not enter buildings if you are sick or experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 or have recently been in contact with someone who has a confirmed or suspected case. If you are actively exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19, you will be provided with other alternatives for library use.
- 2. All patrons 5 years and older must wear a mask covering their face and nose at all times while in the Library or while interacting with library staff or patrons on library property. Masks will be available and offered to those who may not have one. Reasonable accommodations such as delivery service and online resources are available to those who are medically prevented from or decline to wear a face covering over their nose and mouth.
- 3. Individuals will maintain six feet of physical distancing between themselves and others within the library or while on library property.
- 4. Patrons are expected to follow all signage, staff requests, floor markings or other signage placed for the purpose of regulating physical distancing.
- 5. Food and drinks are not allowed within the library.
