## 2. Track your reading and activities on this log or online.

You can use the reading log on the other side, or set up an online account through Beanstack: [cbcpublishing.beanstack.org](http://cbcpublishing.beanstack.org). Online participation is not required.

- Each day you read, or activity you complete, earns you 1 point.
- Earn at least 10 points to enter the prize drawing. Prizes may include gift certificates to local businesses.
- Each 10 points you earn = 1 entry into the prize drawing, with a maximum of 5 entries.
- One log per participant for the summer.

## 3. Return your paper reading log by September 10 to enter the prize drawing.

If you use Beanstack, you will be automatically entered into eligible prize drawings.
