



### 1. Get a free book and bag.

Participants receive one free book and bag at a library branch (or request one by delivery) while supplies last. To request delivery, send an email to:

### 2. Track your reading and activities on this log.

- Each day you read, or activity you complete, earns you 1 point.
- Earn at least 10 points to enter the prize drawing. Prizes may include gift certificates to local businesses.
- Every 10 points you earn = 1 entry into the prize drawing, with a maximum of 5 entries.
- One log per participant for the summer.

### 3. Return your reading log by September 10.
