A runaway girl discovers she has the unique power to enter Faerie and bring back magic to Earth.

Brennan, Herbie. **Faerie Wars**

Troubled by family problems, Henry finds his life taking a whole new dimension when he becomes involved with Prince Pyrgus Malvae, who's hiding from the treacherous Faeries of the Night.

De Lint, Charles. **Little (grrl) Lost**

When TJ and her family are forced to move from their farm to the suburbs, she has to give up her beloved horse, Red - but she makes a surprising new friend: Elizabeth is a "Little," a six-inch-high punked-out teen with an attitude, who has run away from home to make her way in the world.

Dunkle, Clare. **The Hollow Kingdom**

In nineteenth-century England, a powerful sorcerer and King of the Goblins chooses Kate, the elder of two orphan girls recently arrived at their ancestral home, Hallow Hill, to be his bride and queen.



Funke, Cornelia. **Fearless**

Jacob Reckless journeys to the Mirrorworld to tell his shapeshifting friend Fox that a fairy curse - a deadly moth in his chest - means he has only one year to live.

Hamilton, Kersten. **Tyger Tyger: A Goblin Wars Book**

Soon after the mysterious and alluring Finn arrives at her family's home, sixteen-year-old Teagan is drawn into the battle Finn's family has fought since the thirteenth century, when they angered the goblin king.

Hamilton, Kiki. **The Faerie Ring**

The year is 1871, and Tiki has been supporting herself and her family of orphans by picking pockets. One December night, Tiki steals a ring, and sets off a chain of events that could lead to all-out war with the Fey.

Healy, Karen. **Guardian of the Dead**

Ellie must use her rusty tae kwon do skills and new-found magic to try to stop fairy-like creatures from Maori legends that are plotting to kill millions of humans in order to regain their lost immortality.

Jones, Carrie. **Need**

Zara goes to live with her grandmother in a small Maine town, where new friends tell Zara the strange man she keeps seeing may be a pixie king, and that only "were" creatures can stop him from taking souls.

Jones, Diana Wynne. **Fire and Hemlock**

At nineteen, Polly has two sets of overlapping memories: the real-life ones of school days and her parents' divorce, and the heroic adventure ones that began the day she accidentally gate-crashed a funeral and met the cellist Thomas Lynn.



Kagawa, Julie. **The Iron King**

Meghan has never fit in and now, on the eve of her 16th birthday, she finally discovers why. When her brother is kidnapped, she's drawn into a fantastical world she had never imagined - the world of Faery.

Larbalestier, Justine. **How to Ditch Your Fairy**

In a world in which everyone has a personal fairy who tends to one aspect of daily life, Charlie decides she does not want hers - a parking fairy - and embarks on a quest to replace it with a better one.

Livingston, Lesley. **Wondrous Strange**

When seventeen-year-old Kelley meets Sonny Flannery, she discovers he is a faerie changeling and she faerie heritage, too.

Lo, Malinda. **Huntress**

Seventeen-year-olds Kaede and Taisin are called to go on a dangerous and unprecedented journey to Tanlili, the city of the Fairy Queen, in an effort to restore the balance of nature in the human world.

Marr, Melissa. **Wicked Lovely**

Aislinn, who has the rare ability to see faeries, is drawn against her will into a centuries-old battle between the Summer King and Winter Queen, and her life and love all hang in the balance.

Melling, O.R. **The Hunter's Moon**

Two teenage cousins, one Irish, the other from the United States, set out to find a magic doorway to the Faraway Country where fairies live.

Moon, Fabio. **Ursula** *YA Graphics Moon, Fabio

Once upon a time there was a story, and it was a love story. Prince Miro adores a girl named Ursula - so when his father tells him to go out and find a bride, he tracks Ursula down. But Ursula is a fairy, and fairies explode when they fall in love.



Pike, Aprilynne. **Wings**

When a plant blooms out of Laurel's back, she discovers that she's a faerie and that she has a crucial role to play in keeping the world safe from the encroaching enemy trolls.

Pratchett, Terry. **Wee Free Men**

A young witch-to-be named Tiffany teams up with the Wee Free Men, a clan of six-inch-high blue men, to rescue her baby brother and ward off a sinister invasion from Fairyland.

Stiefvater, Maggie. **Lament: The Faerie Queen's Deception**

16-year-old Dierdre Monaghan, discovers that she is a cloverhand - one who can see faeries. Dierdre soon finds herself trapped in the middle of a centuries-old faerie war.

Taylor, Laini. **Daughter of Smoke and Bone**

Meet Karou. She fills her sketchbooks with monsters that may or may not be real; she's prone to disappearing on mysterious "errands"; she speaks many languages - not all of them human; and her bright blue hair actually grows out of her head that color. Who is she? That is the question that haunts her, and she's about to find out.

Taylor, Laini. **Lips Touch Three Times**

Three tales of supernatural love, each pivoting on a kiss that is no mere kiss, but an action with profound consequences for the kissers' souls.

Thompson, Kate. **The Last of the High Kings**

When Jenny learns that she is a changeling and makes a deal with a devil creature, she endangers the human race; but her own cleverness, her human and fairy fathers, and the last of Ireland's High Kings help to make things right.

Werlin, Nancy. **Extraordinary**

Phoebe befriends Mallory, a new girl in school, and the two become as close . . . but Phoebe does not know that Mallory is a faerie, sent to the human world to trap her into fulfilling a promise made by her ancestor Mayer to the queen of the faeries.

Yovanoff, Brenna. **The Replacement**

Mackie Doyle is not one of us; he comes from a world of tunnels and black murky water, a world of living dead girls ruled by a little tattooed princess. He is a Replacement - left in the crib of a human baby sixteen years ago. Now, because of fatal allergies to iron, blood, and consecrated ground, Mackie is fighting to survive in the human world.

Yuki, Kaori. **Fairy Cube** *YA Graphics Fairy

Ian Hasumi can see fairies, including his constant shadow, a green-haired, red-eyed doppelgänger called Tokage. When Tokage decides that he wants a body, he arranges to steal Ian's.
