



Alphin, Elaine Marie. **Counterfeit Son**
When serial killer Hank Miller is killed in a shoot-out with police, his abused son Cameron adopts the identity of one of his father's victims in order to find a better life.

Beitia, Sara. **The Last Good Place of Lily Odilon**
When seventeen-year-old Albert's girlfriend Lily goes missing, he must deflect the worries of his angry parents, the suspicions of the police, and Lily's dangerous stepfather as he desperately tries to find her, with her sister as his only ally.

Bell, Julia. **Dirty Work**
Two teenaged girls with little in common must find a way to work together if they are ever to escape their captors after being abducted into an international prostitution ring.

Bloor, Edward. **Taken**
In 2035 kidnapping rich children has become an industry, but when thirteen-year-old Charity Meyers is taken and held for ransom, she soon discovers that this particular kidnapping is not what it seems.

Cabot, Meg. Vanished: **Books Three and Four**
After emerging from a thunderstorm with psychic ability, Jessica searches for the killer of a popular cheerleader and works with a government agent to locate a missing child, believed to have been taken by a backwoods militia.

Carlson, Melody. **Bad Connection: A Novel**
Samantha is gifted: God gives her visions and dreams that offer glimpses into other people's lives. It's a powerful gift with a lot of responsibility, especially when she has a vision involving a girl that's gone missing.



Christopher, Lucy. **Stolen**
Gemma is abducted while on vacation with her parents and taken to the remote Australian outback; in time she learns that her captor is not as despicable as she first believed.

Cochrane, Mick. **Fitz: A Novel**
Fifteen-year-old Fitz kidnaps the father he has never known, taking him from his St. Paul apartment building at gunpoint, in an attempt to address his bewildering mix of resentment and yearning.

Coley, Liz. **Pretty Girl-13**
Sixteen-year-old Angie finds herself in her neighborhood with no recollection of her abduction or the three years that have passed since . . . until alternate personalities start telling her their stories through letters and recordings.

Cooney, Caroline. **The Face on the Milk Carton**
A photograph of a missing girl on a milk carton leads Janie on a search for her real identity.

Crutcher, Chris. **Period 8**
Period 8 has always been a safe haven for Paulie - the only rule: tell the truth. When a classmate goes missing, he realizes that someone has been lying.

Davies, Stephen. **Outlaw: A Novel**
Jake and his sister, Kas, are abducted, bundled into a van, and driven into the unknown, kidnapped by a notorious international terrorist.

DeStefano, Lauren. **Wither**
After modern science turns every human into a genetic time bomb with men dying at age twenty-five and women dying at age twenty, girls are kidnapped and married off in order to repopulate the world.



Hautman, Pete and Mary Logue. **Snatched**
Too curious for her own good, Roni, crime reporter for her high school newspaper, investigates the beating and kidnapping of a classmate.

Henry, April. **Girl, Stolen**
When an impulsive carjacking turns into a kidnapping, Griffin, a high school dropout, finds himself more in sympathy with his wealthy, blind victim, sixteen-year-old Cheyenne, than with his greedy father.

Jacobson, Jennifer. **Stained**
Seventeen-year-old Jocelyn looks for answers when her lifelong neighbor and friend, Gabe, turns up missing; she learns he has been keeping terrible secrets.

Jones, Diana Wynne. **A Tale of Time City**
London, 1939. Vivian Smith thinks she is being evacuated to the countryside, because of the war. But she is being kidnapped - out of her own time.

Kasischke, Laura. **Feathered**
While on Spring Break in Cancun, high-school seniors and best friends Anne and Michelle accept the wrong ride and Michelle is lost - seemingly forever.

Mazer, Norma Fox. **The Missing Girl**
As five sisters, aged eleven to seventeen, deal with assorted problems, conflicts, fears, and yearnings, a mysterious middle-aged man watches them, fascinated, deciding which one he likes the best.

McBride, Kristina. **The Tension of Opposites**
Tessa has been living in suspended animation since her best friend was kidnapped at the age of fourteen, and when she suddenly returns, both of them, along with the people they love, must deal with the emotional aftermath of the terrible ordeal.



McMann, Lisa. **Dead to You**
 Having been abducted at age seven, Ethan, is happy to be home until his brother's suspicion and his own inability to remember his early childhood begin to tear the family apart.

Mitchard, Jacquelyn. **Now You See Her**
 Fifteen-year-old Hope describes events leading her to agree to her boyfriend's plan to stage her abduction, and the consequences for their lives.

Rapp, Adam. **The Children and the Wolves**
 Abducted by teen genius Bounce and her friends, three-year-old Frog seems content to eat cereal and play video games until one of them is overcome by guilt and takes action.

Scott, Elizabeth. **Living Dead Girl**
 When Alice was ten, Ray took her away from her family, her friends, her life. She learned to give up all power, to endure all pain. She waited for the nightmare to be over. Now Alice is fifteen and Ray still has her, but he speaks more and more of her death. He does not know it is what she longs for. She does not know he has something more terrifying than death in mind for her.

Strasser, Todd. **Wish You Were Dead**
 Madison tries to evade a stalker and uncover who is responsible for the disappearance of students mentioned in the posts of an anonymous blogger.

Valentine, Jenny. **Double**
 When Chap is mistaken for a missing boy, he takes on this new identity, not knowing that it is as dangerous and uncertain as the life he has left behind.



Vance, Susanna. **Deep**
 Seventeen-year-old Morgan and thirteen-year-old Birdie, two girls whose lives are worlds apart, are brought together by the maniacal Nicholas.

Vrettos, Adrienne. **Sight**
 Sixteen-year-old Dylan uses her psychic abilities to help police solve crimes against children, but keeps it secret from her friends at school.

White, Ellen Emerson. **Long May She Reign**
 Meg, daughter of the president of the United States, is recovering from a brutal kidnapping. In an effort to deal with her horrific experience she decides to go away for her second semester of college, where she encounters even more challenges.

Yovanoff, Brenna. **The Replacement**
 Sixteen-year-old Mackie Doyle knows that he replaced a human child when he was just an infant, and when a friend's sister disappears he goes against his family's and town's deliberate denial of the problem to confront the beings that dwell under the town, tampering with human lives.
