McKay, Kirsty. *Undead*

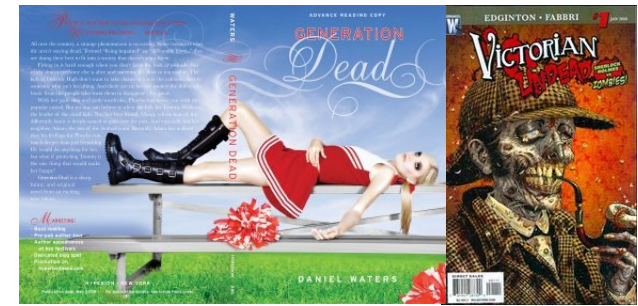

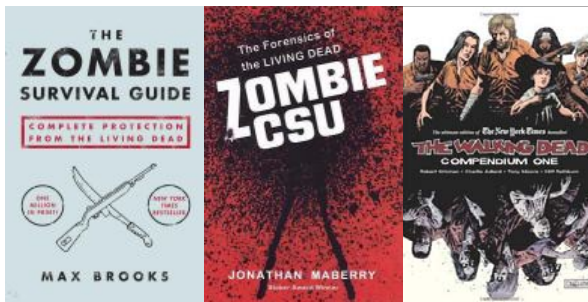
